




1. Download latest version of Turning Point


# PowerPoint Polling Start Now

3. Then Click on TurningPoint




## Create Question in PowerPoint using TurningPoint



# During Polling


- Click on  Mobile Responses check mark to Enable students to make selections on their phone.

- You will set your Session ID and then click Start Session




- Next you will see the Session Status and a Session Duration timer.  
**\*\*Do not click on End Session**






1. Click on Start

3. Click on Turing Point, Reset, and Session




## Save Student Results
